Purple Flag for Bury

Purple Flag is an award scheme for town and city centres similar to blue flags awarded to beaches. It is a 'gold standard' which recognises excellence in the way town and city centres manage their evening and night time economy.

To achieve Purple Flag status towns and cities must show that they:

- **Are well-managed, offering a safe enjoyable night out**
- **Provide a vibrant, positive experience with a diverse mix of venues, entertainment and activity that appeal to all**
- **Welcome everybody**
- **Offer a range of safe transport options**

Bury will benefit from a higher quality environment, more visitors, lower crime and anti-social behaviour delivered through strong partnership working.

What makes Bury a Purple Flag Town Centre?

Bury is the only town in Greater Manchester to be awarded Purple Flag which reflects the strong evening and night time offer.

With culture and theatre, music and comedy, food and dining, plus an expanding programme of festivals and events, including the annual Bury Light Night event. Bury is a great evening destination!
